Before Getting Started With the Plugin Installation

- Please make sure that you have the plugin zip file downloaded to your computer. If you received this file as an email attachment, please be sure to download it to a location on your computer.
- 2. Please make sure you have PowerSchool version 20.11 or higher running. To check which version of PowerSchool you are running, go to your login screen.
- 3. **Special Note** You are most likely on the latest version of PowerSchool with the 2024 updated user interface. If the screenshots below don't look like your version of PowerSchool, skip to PAGE 8 for plugin installation instructions for older versions of PowerSchool.

Steps to Install Automated Rostering Plugin for PowerSchool

 Login to your PowerSchool account as an administrator. In the left hand navigation, under the "System Management", click the "Server" link, then click the "Plugin Configuration" link.

District Responsibilities
